



“An Image of Orwigsburg” is a silent-bid art auction to benefit the Orwigsburg Bicentennial. All submissions should involve a representation of the community (ie: buildings, landscapes, history, activities, people, events,etc.).

This project is open to all artists and to any medium. Artists will be divided into four categories (ie: elementary school entries, middle school entries, high school and amateur entries, and professional artist entries).

Artwork will be divided into five categories. 1) Wall Art (Painting/Sketches/Chalk) 2) Photography (Color Photos/Black and White Photos) 3) Pottery (Clay/Ceramic) 4) Fiber Art (Quilting/Wall Hangings) 5) Sculpture (Metal/Wood/Glass).

Requirements for submission: 1) Maximum of one entry per person per medium. 2) Maximum finished size for wall art is 16” X 20”. 3) A reserve amount (if any) may be set by the artist. 4) The entry fee will be \$10.00 per entry. The entry fee is waived for elementary and middle school students. 5) Submission deadline is August 11, 2012.

Artwork will be judged by category. Judges will be selected from local artists and art teachers by the Bicentennial Committee. All artwork will be on display for the public at an unveiling event at the Orwigsburg Historical Society on August 18, 2012.

Artwork awarded first, second and third place in each category by the judges will then be displayed at various business locations throughout Orwigsburg until September 7, 2012. Bids can be placed on the artwork throughout this period. All other entries will be available for viewing and silent bids at the Orwigsburg Historical Society or at The Arts Barn just outside Orwigsburg.

All artwork will be available for final bids on Heritage Day, September 8, 2012 at the Orwigsburg Historical Society. Artists will receive 70% of the final sale price, and 30% will benefit the Orwigsburg Bicentennial.
